Research Study

The MISSION Act's Impact on Rural Veteran Access to and Experience of Care: Views of Rural Veterans, non-VA and VA primary care clinics and community service organizations in rural areas (CARAVAN)

Why do you need me?

Volunteers are needed to participate in a research study seeking rural Veterans' experiences in accessing and receiving VA and non-VA primary care.

Why is this important?

The VA is trying to improve rural Veterans' access to better quality care. **Your participation will help Oregon Health & Science University (OHSU) and the VA to better understand the health care experiences of rural Veterans.**

This study is VA funded, but all study visits and interviews are conducted and de-identified by OHSU staff.

What will I be asked to do?

Between now and September 2021, we are asking you to participate in one **hour-long interview**. This interview will be conducted remotely (by phone or video-conferencing). **This is research and not treatment.** Following interview completion, **participants will be mailed a \$50 gift card.**

Eligibility:

Veteran status; reside in rural Oregon, Washington or Idaho; willing to participate, English speaking, and over 18.
